Instructions for Using Return Label

1. Put product(s) to be returned into a box or envelope.
2. Print this page at 100% size on white or light-colored paper. **Make sure "Shrink oversized pages to paper size" is UNCHECKED in your print settings, and do not print on brilliant-colored paper.**
3. Cut out label on dotted line and affix it squarely onto the address side of the parcel, covering up any previous delivery address and barcode without overlapping any adjacent side. If tape or similar material is used, it must not cover any part of the label where postage and fee information is to be recorded.
4. Obliterate any other addresses and barcodes on the outside of the parcel.
5. Take the parcel to a post office or give it to a postal carrier.
