



Revel & eText: How to register for your course

Here's how to register for Revel or etext. To access the Pearson material for your course, you need an invite link from your instructor. If you have not received an invite link, contact your instructor. Open the invite link. Your Pearson course will open or you may have to select an access option. Let's look at those options.

You can enter a prepaid access code this is the right option for you if it code came with your textbook, or if you bought a code from the bookstore. You can buy access using a credit card or PayPal account. Not ready to buy access to your course? Get temporary access to your course without payment for 14 days. You'll be able to upgrade to full access later when you're ready. Once you've selected an access option, sign in with your Pearson account.

Don't have an account? Select Create an account and follow the prompts to create a new Pearson account. You can use the same Pearson account from MyLab Mastering Revel or Pearson Plus. If you choose temporary access as your access option, you'll see info on when your temp access expires. You can then choose to start your 14-day temporary access now or start it later. You can also choose to cancel your temporary access and pay for full access.

To access your Pearson materials again later, go to console.pearson.com. Sign in with the same Pearson account you used before. Once you're signed in, select your course to enter your course and begin studying and learning. You're all set. Stay on task, improve your grades and learn faster with Pearson.
